BADEN-POWELL AWARD

This award is representative of the adult Scouter who has started the journey to making a difference. As was Lord Baden-Powell this adult leader is a trusted mentor, guide, and protector of youth. The nominee nurtures and develops youth to become leaders of character, physical and moral fitness, and sound citizenship and who exemplify a life following the Scout Oath and Law.

CRITERIA:

- Currently registered with the Boy Scouts of America.
- Completed leader-specific training.
- Pursues excellence in Scouting for youth and themselves.
- Makes a difference in the life of Scouts, adult leaders and community members as Baden-Powell did.

YANABE YALANGAWAY AWARD

To recognize a Scouter who has provided outstanding service to the District Committee, and has rendered outstanding service to youth in the community and to the BSA program.

CRITERIA:

- One (1) award is presented annually.
- Previously has received the District Award of Merit... **OR**
- Must currently serve on the District Committee.
- Must have five (5) years or more service at the district-level.
- Must be registered / active within the Yamasee Service Area.

MICHAEL “DOC” GRAYBEAL AWARD

This award is presented annually to honor the memory and tireless endeavors of Dr. Michael Graybeal as an outstanding, tenured and dedicated volunteer with the Kiokee-River District, and the Georgia-Carolina Council. “Doc” Graybeal endeavored tirelessly in supporting Scouting at the unit, district and council-levels where he served for many years and was honored with distinguished awards and accolades. His enduring impact, mentorship, friendship and leadership in Scouting has left a lasting legacy for years to come...

CRITERIA:

- Must be currently registered as an adult volunteer having contributed 10-years minimum continual service to the Georgia-Carolina Council.
- Active in fostering positive, influential and longstanding relationships between the Scouting and non-Scouting communities.
- Demonstrates an unwavering commitment to youth at the unit, district, and council-level.
- Generous in contribution of time, talent and treasure to the Scouting program as an outstanding representative of the Scout Oath & Law in their daily life.
- Must be registered / active within the Kiokee River Service Area.

MARGARET CARDEN OLE’ HOSS AWARD

For more than 45 years, even after her own sons had completed Scouting experience, Margaret Carden helped shape boys into disciplined, responsible, self-reliant men. An Army Veteran, Margaret had great passion for Scouting and ensuring boys successfully completed the program. Years ago, when Creek River was known by other names, the Ole and New Hoss Awards were created to recognize leaders who stayed involved long after their son had completed their Scouting experience. In memory of Margaret, and in the spirit of the Ole and New Hoss Award, the Creek River District created the Margaret Carden Ole' Hoss Award to recognize leaders who have shown dedication to the Scouting program through demanding excellence from local youth.

CRITERIA:

- Must be a registered adult volunteer with 10-years minimum service to the Georgia-Carolina Council with a demonstrated history in Scouting excellence.
- Demonstrate innovative, motivational leadership impacting Scouts in their academics, Scouting growth and community service beyond the everyday Scouting program.
- Must be registered / active within the Creek River Service Area.
